ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons, being duly authorized and being citizens of the County of Blanco, State of Texas, whose names and addresses are hereafter shown and whose signatures are subscribed hereto, do hereby, under the provisions of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, form and incorporate the congregation and members of the unincorporated religious association now known as the First United Methodist Church, Johnson City, pursuant to action of the Church Conference of said congregation held on January 14, 1996, and conducted in accordance with the applicable governing bylaws, rules and laws of such religious association, into a voluntary association and body corporate (a non-profit corporation) for the purposes of the worship of Almighty God and instruction in the Christian religion, and to that end do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for the corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be FIRST UNITED METHODIST CHURCH, JOHNSON CITY, INC.

ARTICLE II

The corporation is a non-profit corporation and shall continue to function as a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III

The period of duration for said corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to maintain a local congregation of The United Methodist Church. The management of the affairs of the corporation shall be vested in and governed by The Book of Discipline of The United Methodist Church as the same now exists or may hereafter be amended by the General Conference of The United Methodist Church.

ARTICLE V

The house of worship and place of business of the corporation shall be at 105 North LBJ Drive, Johnson City, Blanco County, Texas 78636, where its principal office will be located.

ARTICLE VI

The initial members of the corporation shall be the members of the Church Conference of the First United Methodist Church, Johnson City, duly elected according to the Discipline of The United Methodist Church. Thereafter members shall be all those additional persons elected members according to the Discipline of The United Methodist Church.

ARTICLE VII

The corporation shall have no capital stock, as it is not formed for purposes of gain or profit in any manner, but is and shall remain a non-profit corporation. In the event it is dissolved or otherwise ceases to exist, all the property belonging thereto at the time of dissolution or other termination shall become the property of and shall be distributed in accordance to the Discipline of The United Methodist Church to (and only to) one or more organizations, described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States of America.

ARTICLE VIII

The street address of its initial registered office is 105 North LBJ Drive, Johnson City, Texas 78636. The name of its initial registered agent at such street address is Tom Mills.

ARTICLE IX


